The south office building facade and main entrance elevation is constructed on a radius and features an aluminum curtain wall system with green tinted glass. Color-matching aluminum metal panels and architectural precast concrete complete the elevation. The main building entrance is connected to the three-story parking structure with an arcade and covered walkway.
