

Historic Army post to feature J-J Hook precast concrete barrier

The Department of the Army has purchased 2,184 linear feet of Smith-Midland Corp.'s precast concrete J-J Hooks barrier connection at a cost of \$115,000 for use at a Fort Myer military base in Arlington, Va. The barrier will be used to guard, separate and direct traffic at the main entrance to the base.

Because the barrier, which was installed the week of June 25, will be placed in a high-profile location in close proximity to historic brick buildings some of which were constructed in the Civil War, the 182 pieces of barrier will feature a brick-imprinted façade stained a brick-red color. Installation is expected to occur the week of June 25.
